"Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another... (Hebrews 10:25)"



We believe that Christian education is important at all age levels, that all of Christ's people in faith and love might grow in Him.



We believe that our Lord has given parents the privilege and responsibility of training their children in the way of Jesus.

To assist our members in this task and in their faith and wisdom, our church provides the following education programs:

- Christian Day School for children in grades K-8. We offer a daily, well-rounded education in God's Word and other areas of study such as: mathematics, literature and language, history, science, and art.
- Sunday School for children 3 years through grade 8, Sunday's at 10 am during the school season.
- Summer Vacation Bible School for children age 4 thru 8th grade.

- Adult Bible Study, Sundays at 10 am during the school season.
- Basic Bible Instruction Classes for both youth and adults. This is for individuals who are unfamiliar with the Bible's teachings and would like to learn about the foundations of the Christian faith. It is also offered as part of the Christian Day School curriculum for children in grades 6-8.
